Storage	In the Ice Palace on the Jungfraujoch – Top of Europe (3'454 m) at a constant temperature of -4 °C
Aged	Exclusively in Oloroso sherry cask (No. 88) made of American white oak
Bottled	February 2025, limited quantity 952 Bottles 50 cl e
Alcohol content	alc. 52,2% Vol.
Special characteristics	Single cask, cask strength, unfiltered

Tasting Notes

Colour	Golden yellow with subtle hints of brown.
Body	The honey-sweet start transitions into a peppery, spicy note. A full-bodied, mineral whisky with a lingering aroma.
Scent	Pleasant caramel sweetness and chocolate notes unfold with a slightly spicy character. This whisky is distinguished by a bouquet of toasted caramelised hazelnuts and almonds.
Palate	Full-bodied, pleasantly harmonious start. The palate is literally enveloped by the honey-sweet, slightly spicy notes. Sultanas and dried plums lend a subtle aroma of fruits. Long and smooth, the finish continues to evolve into a caramelly, chocolatey malt note.
